## **Advice on Costs and Status of Council's Court Proceedings**

## **Executive Summary**

- 1. Advice on Council's Court proceedings for the period 1 June 2021 to 30 June 2021 is contained within this report.
- 2. Total legal costs to date for the 2020/21 financial year are \$2,436,208.00.
- 3. Total legal costs recovered to date for the 2020/21 financial year are \$463,891.00.
- 4. Total costs incurred by Council in legal proceedings are \$1,919,147.00.
- 5. Total nett costs are \$1,972,318.00.
