## Overview

The Uncontained Arts Festival is returning to Kogarah in June 2026.

This festival enlivens Belgrave Street, Kogarah and increases the cultural vibrancy of the area. It disrupts what people think of as ‘art’, sparks curiosity and generates a sense of play in the community, bringing new contemporary artists to the area, and providing a platform for local artists to showcase their works.

This opportunity would suit those who have a keen interest in art and/or culture, event management and enjoys interacting with the public.

The Uncontained Arts Festival will take place on the 26, 27, and 28 June 2026.

## Responsibilities

As a volunteer at the Uncontained Arts Festival, you will have the opportunity to invigilate and provide interpretation for artworks where necessary. Volunteers will be rostered from 4.30pm to 10.00pm on either the 26, 27, and 28 June 2026. There will be an induction before your shift.

Tasks will include:

- Ensuring artworks and installations are not touched or photographed by visitors as indicated
- Ensuring all interactive components are functioning
- Providing general information to the public
- Providing crowd control/line management
- Notifying onsite staff if anything requires their attention

Skills required:

- Effective communication skills
- Ability to work independently
- Working With Children Check (free to obtain for volunteers)
- Interest in art and culture or events management



- Ability to stand for periods of time
