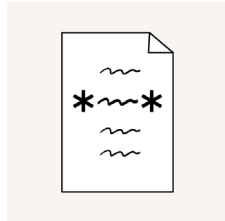

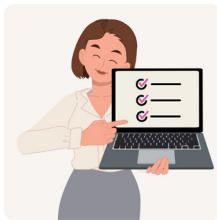
This book is from Georges River Council.

These are rules you must follow to work with us.

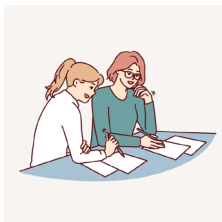

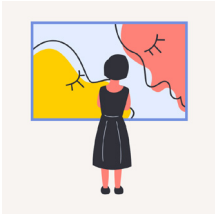

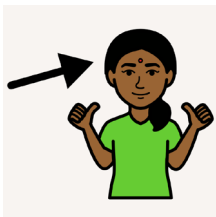

We want to know

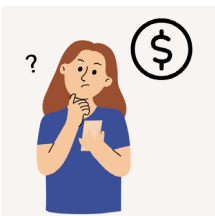
- what art you want to make



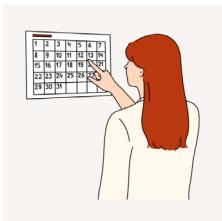
- why you want to make your art



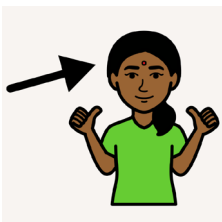
- where you want your art to be



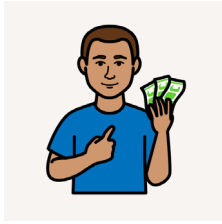
- what you need to make your art



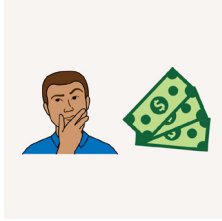
- **how long** you need to make your project

We want to know your ***budget***.

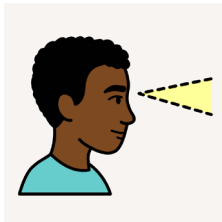


A budget says

- how you will use the money. For example, to buy a video camera to make a short film.



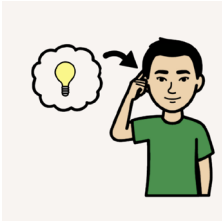
We want to see pictures of your other art.

How we choose

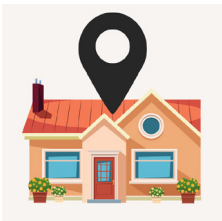


We will choose projects that

- we think will be good for our community

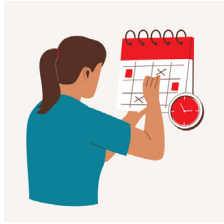


- include new ideas

We will email you within **2 weeks**.



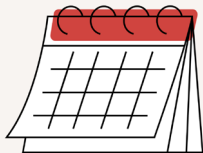
You must finish your project and give us your art by a date we will agree on if we choose you.

- ***install*** your project



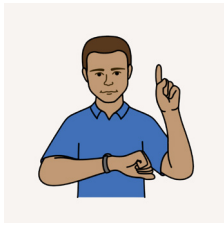
- finish your project

You must follow the rules for people who work with us.

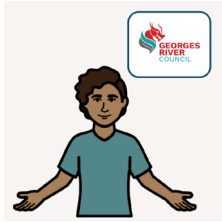


You must finish your project on time.

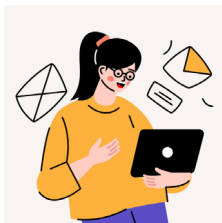


You must tell us what you want to happen if your art is damaged.

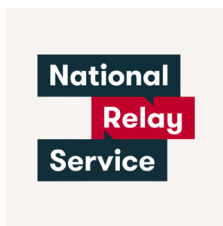

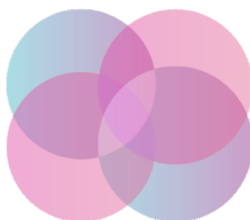
