

GEORGES RIVER COUNCIL 2019 CLUBGRANTS LOCAL GRANT ROUND: PRIORITY COMMUNITY NEEDS

- 1. Community safety and crime prevention programs that support families affected by domestic violence.
- 2. Programs that reduce social isolation for older people, including veterans.
- 3. Provision of programs, events or resources that support families with young children, and build networks for isolated parents.
- 4. Programs or resources that benefit people with disabilities and their families.
- 5. Programs, events or resources which foster inclusion, community harmony, strengthen community networks, and reduce religious and racial intolerance.
- 6. Programs that provide assistance and/or education to young people in areas such as drugs and alcohol, healthy eating, physical activity, bullying and respectful relationships.
- 7. Programs that focus on early intervention and support 0-3 years old children, younger parents and/or Aboriginal families.
- 8. Programs or resources that support volunteer emergency services and increased volunteerism in the community.
- 9. Programs or resources that support individuals and families who are financially disadvantaged.
- 10. Programs or resources that support individuals who are experiencing or recovering from serious illnesses, including mental health.
