Accessible continuous path of travel. MacMahon street will be closed to traffic from Dora St up until 7 MacMahon St ensuring a continuous and accessible path of travel both on the pavement and sidewalk.

Accessible parking. 5 parking bays will be reserved for accessible parking next to the event area in MacMahon street car park.

Accessible toilets available in the Marana auditorium.

Seating. Bar tables and stools will be available. If you require an accessible table or a chair with a backrest, please let staff know so they can accommodate.

Assistance animals are welcome to the event. A water bowl will be available for service animals in front of the Marana auditorium.

Quiet space will not be available.

Access to power to recharge mobility scooters will be available at the Marana auditorium.

Auslan interpreter will <u>not</u> be available during the event. Most entertainment will consist of traditional dances from different cultures.

Closed/open captions will not be available.
