**Accessible path of travel**. Please note the event is held at a park. Food and entertainment areas are located on grass (uneven surface) about 30-60m from the closest footpath.

Accessible parking and drop-off zone available. Note there is a long ramp with speed bumps from the accessible parking/drop-off zone to the park and assistance might be required. If you will be coming alone and require assistance, please contact the organizers.
