

### GEORGES RIVER COUNCIL COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM 2019-2020 ROUND 1 SUMMARY OF APPLICATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Georges River Council Community Grants Program 2019-2020 Round 1 closed on Monday 2 September 2019.

A total of 38 applications were received for funding, with funding requests totalling \$372,480.

The budget allocation for Round 1 of the 2019-2020 Community Grants Program is \$160,000.

This grant round comprised two categories:

**Vibrant Georges River – Major Programs** Grants of up to \$25,000 over 2 years for programs and projects to establish arts and cultural programs of significance and create opportunities for local residents to participate in cultural activities in line with Council's Cultural Strategy.

**Capacity Building Grants – Community Development** Grants of up to \$10,000 to assist in the delivery of community programs and projects, especially those that benefit the most vulnerable communities and build capacity in the community.
