This application is to request an exemption from requiring development consent under clause 5.10(3)(a) of the Georges River Local Environmental Plan 2021 for proposed development that is (i) of a minor nature or is for the maintenance of the heritage item, Aboriginal object, Aboriginal place of heritage significance or archaeological site or a building, work, relic, tree or place within the heritage conservation area, and (ii) would not adversely affect the heritage significance of the heritage item, Aboriginal object, Aboriginal place, archaeological site or heritage conservation area.

Minor works generally include repairs and maintenance of heritage buildings, repainting of a residential building in a colour scheme supported by Council's Heritage Advisor or replacement of building elements on a "like for like" basis.
