Abandoned shopping trolleys in public areas



A person who is caught abandoning a shopping trolley in a public place may be issued a Penalty Notice and required to pay a fine of \$220.

In Australia, shopping trolleys belong to supermarkets and shopping centres. They are only for use inside the supermarket and shopping centre. They are not a transport tool for carrying your shopping items from the shop to your home, and then to be abandoned outside of your home on the street.

Abandoned shopping trolleys in public areas are both an eyesore and a potential hazard for pedestrians and motorists alike.

Help prevent trolley dumping and protect public safety:

- Leave shopping trolleys at the shop
- Use your own trolley
