Accessibility Information

Continuous path of travel. Belgrave Street will be closed to traffic from Post Office Lane to Kensington Street. There will be art installations and stalls on both sides of the street and Kogarah Town Square. Attendees will be able to walk on both footpaths and on the street.

There will be a free laser tag activation in the carpark on top of the stairs in front of 2 Belgrave St. Accessibility to that area will be via Post Office Ln, Wicks Ln and then through the car park.

Accessible parking. In addition to the usual accessible parking spots in the area, five additional spots will be reserved for accessible parking for the duration of the event. These additional spots will be located next to the two accessible parking spots on 1 Belgrave St, Kogarah NSW 2217.

Designated drop off area available at 1 Belgrave St, Kogarah.

Accessible toilets. Available at Clive James Library, Kogarah.

Baby change space available and located inside the Clive James Library, Kogarah

Seating. Benches, stools and chairs will be available in Kogarah Town Square and around the event site. Some fixed furniture and the chairs have back rests. No arm rest available.

Access to power points to recharge mobility scooters located inside the Clive James Library, Kogarah. Please contact the Events Team if you require access.

Assistance animals are welcome to the event. A water bowl will be available for service animals on Belgrave St in front of Kogarah Town Square.

Quiet space will be available in Clive James Library, Kogarah.

Sensory Information: Most installations entail bright lights. There will be a DJ for the duration of the event playing music at Kogarah Town Square. A live music performance from JP Music will also play for the event duration on Belgrave St near Post Office Lane. There will be roving performances that will entail bright and moving lights. An aerial performance entailing loud music, movement and lights will take place in front of Greek Orthodox Parish and Community of Kogarah Church at

7.00pm and 8.30pm each night. Multiple installations will have sound and visual projections.

Auslan interpreter will be available during pre-booked Betty Grumble Art Tours at 5:15pm each night.
